Wyckoff Heights Medical Center offers a one-year Pharmacy Residency Program (PGY1). This new program offers a variety of learning opportunities at an established teaching hospital located in a diverse neighborhood in Brooklyn, NY. The program's primary goals are to equip the resident with the knowledge, skills, confidence, and abilities to provide care in a direct patient care setting. In this program, the resident will train under a passionate and expert pharmacy faculty, in a multidisciplinary team to provide comprehensive medication therapy management across a broad spectrum of medical populations.



**PGY1 pharmacy residency programs** build on Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) education and outcomes to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists responsible for medication-related care of patients with a wide range of conditions, eligible for board certification, and eligible for postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.

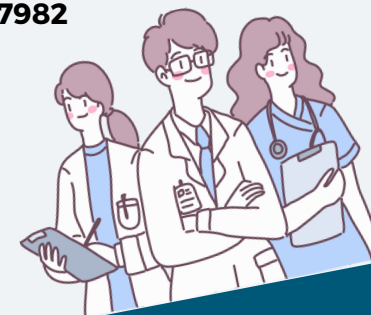
